1991 Colonel Crawford State Track Champions

The headlines in 1991 read "Colonel Crawford Champions Again." These six young ladies had already brought the school its' first state title in 1990. This second state title was just as special as the first.

The championship was accomplished in events ran throughout the meet. The first event of the day was the 100 meter hurdles in which Erin Ebner (15.06) and Ashley Lawson (15.24) finished second and fourth, respectively. Next the 800 meter relay (1:46.07) of Michelle Stuckman, Dawn Spears, Christi Laughbaum and Erin Ebner defended their state title from the previous year and established a school record. The 400 meter relay (50.25) of Erin Ebner, Robyn Fogle, Christi Laughbaum and Michelle Stuckman did the same in defending their state title from a year ago and set a school record as well. The fourth event of the day for the track team was the 300 meter hurdles where Ashley Lawson (44.97) and Erin Ebner (47.13) worked their magic again and placed first and sixth, respectively. Michelle Stuckman (26.4) locked up the second state title for the team by placing third in the 200 meter dash and also established a school record in doing so.

These young ladies ran in five events and won a state championship title in three of them. Assistant Coach Jarvis summed it up best that day when he said "You just can't put it into words. It's a wonderful group of girls and they deserve everything they've gotten because they worked so hard."
