Stephanie was an all-around athlete at Buckeye Central excelling in volleyball and basketball. Stephanie lettered four years in each sport and also played softball and track. Stephanie is the only Buckeye Central athlete to have been a member of two state volleyball championship teams in 1993 and 1996.

Stephanie's basketball accomplishments are tremendous. She was named an All-Ohioan three times, first team NCC three times, all district twice, and the Crawford County Player of the Year, twice! Stephanie holds several school records including field goal percentage at 62% in a season, single game scoring record of 39, all-time leading rebounder with 797 boards and is the career leading scorer with 1,335 points.

In volleyball, Stephanie was a two-time all NCC first team member, first team district, first team All-News Journal and first team All-Ohio. In addition, her volleyball teams went 95-9 during her career.

Stephanie graduated in 2001 from Eastern Michigan University. She currently lives in Farmington Hills, Michigan with her 7 year old son, Colin. She works in compliance for a utility company.
